School Days is a quilt project brought to you through Quilt Block Mania by The Quilted Diary.

1. Sew Wall B $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip and Wall A $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle together. Press open resulting in a $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

2. Stack the Wall B and Ceiling $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on top of each other. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Sew on the line. Trim leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press open. Trim to a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ half square triangle.
3. Sew the Wall B $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to the left side of the HST, resulting in a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ unit.

4. Join the Ceiling $2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of the unit from step three. Press.

Strip measures $2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
5. Stack the Wall B and Floor $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares on top of each other.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and sew on the line. Trim leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press open. Trim to a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ half square triangle.

6. Attach the Floor $3^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of the HST.
7. Join the three units together as pictured. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.


## Get Creative!

Use your alma mater's colors! What was the color of cafeteria floor? How about the walls? Remember when choosing colors, you need to use two different wall fabrics one slightly lighter than the other to achieve the dimensional look.
\# Do you remember what your school lunch cost? Swap out those numbers with mine! How about the lunch menu? For the lunch signs use your school pride colors.

## Applique \& Embroidery

The applique templates have a quarter inch seam allowance added. For fusible applique, cut your pieces on the solid line.
Trace the letters for the signs onto your fabric or print page three onto fabric. Use a backstitch.
